

VIBRANT VILLAGE PROGRAMME- ARUNACHAL PRADESH

- The Vibrant Villages Programme (VVP) was announced in Union Budget 2022- 2023 and was launched on 10/04/2023 by Shri Amit Shah, Hon’ble Union Home Minister at Kibithoo village, Anjaw District, Arunachal Pradesh.
- It covers 455 villages in 11 districts of Arunachal Pradesh. The summary of villages covered in Arunachal Pradesh is mentioned below.

- Respective DCs had proposed projects under Action Plan which spread across 5 main sectors –
 - **Livelihood**
 - **Skill development and Capacity Building**
 - **Tourism Development Highlights**
 - **Ecosystem Regeneration**
 - **Village Infrastructure**

- **Approval of Other Projects under VVP**

MHA has recently approved 187 projects, for 156 villages in 10 districts, with an estimated cost of Rs 104.99 Crores under VVP. These projects include:

- 67 tourism projects like Eco / Adventure tourism, View Point, Way side amenities, Trekking, etc. amounting to Rs. 30.60 Crores
- 114 village infrastructure schemes (Community Hall, Multi Purpose Hall, etc) of Rs 74.15 Crores
- 6 eco-regeneration schemes (Brushwood Check Dam) of Rs 24 lakhs.

The project is being implemented by respective DCs through DRDA, BDOs, RWD, PWD and Forest Department, etc.

An amount of Rs. 24.25 crore has been released as 1st installment (25%) to respective DCs through PFMS, SNA module.

- **Approval of Road Projects-**

105 roads, covering 1,022 km and connecting 125 habitations, with an estimated cost of Rs 2,205 Crores have been sanctioned under VVP. The projects are being implemented by Rural Works Department (RWD).

An amount of Rs. 80.28 crore (Including Center & State Share) has been released as 1st installment (25%).
